This agreement entered into this \_\_\_\_\_, by and between Carolina Poodle Rescue (CPR) and \_\_\_\_\_ (Adopter) is subject to the following conditions.

**CONSIDERATION:** The consideration for this contract is transfer of ownership of the dog ("Dog") described below and payment in full of \$\_\_\_\_\_ (\_\_\_\_\_ cash \_\_\_\_\_ check \_\_\_\_\_ credit card) for said Dog presented to CPR.

**RETURN OF DOG:** Adopter agrees to return Dog to CPR if for any reason Adopter decides Dog is no longer suitable for their home, if Dog becomes ill and Adopter cannot or will not provide medical care, or for any other reason whatsoever. Adopter understands and agrees that the Consideration set out on paragraph 1 above shall not be refunded in the event of Dog's return to the CPR. If dog is returned for any reasons, Adopter shall provide CPR a copy of Dog's medical records. Adopter agrees and understands that under no circumstances shall Dog be taken to any animal shelter, other rescue organization or any individual or organization whatsoever.

**ADOPTER AGREES TO MAINTAIN DOG ON MONTHLY HEARTWORM PREVENTATIVE AND REGULAR FLEA PREVENTATIVE.  
ADOPTER AGREES TO MAINTAIN DOG IN AN INDOOR HOME.  
ADOPTER AGREES TO MAINTAIN DOG IN A CLEAN AND NEATLY GROOMED MANNER, FREE OF MATS.**

**PROPER CARE:**

**FEEDING:** Dog shall be provided with regular, adequate, appropriate and wholesome food and water. Adopter agrees to follow any special health care or feeding recommendations noted in the health record.

**HOUSING:** Adopter agrees to provide Dog with an indoor home (primary living area for dog inside the adoptive home at the primary address) \_\_\_\_\_ (**Adopter's initials**)

**VETERINARY CARE:** Dog shall be promptly taken to a licensed veterinarian at any time Dog appears to be ill or injured. If Dog is less than 16 weeks of age, Dog shall receive DHLPP shots every three weeks from age 6 to 16 weeks. Thereafter, Dog shall

receive an annual veterinary examination that shall include a physical, appropriate vaccinations including rabies, DHLPP and Heartworm testing, and any necessary routine laboratory examinations. Adopter agrees to maintain Dog on regular flea/tick and heartworm preventative program. All veterinary care incurred after the date of this contract is the sole responsibility of the adopter unless stated otherwise herein.

**NON MUTILATION:** Adopter agrees and understands that at no time may they mutilate or physically change their dog in any way for strictly cosmetic purposes. This shall include tail docking and ear cropping.

**HEALTH/BEHAVIOR DISCLAIMER:** Adopter agrees and understands that changes in health and behavior cannot be predicted, and that the CPR makes no warranties, representations or guarantees whatsoever as to the temperament, characteristics or health of Dog, and that nothing in the Contract represents any explicit or implied warranties of fitness, merchantability, future health or behavior. \_\_\_\_\_ (Adopter's initials)

**CHANGE OF PHONE NUMBER OR ADDRESS:** Adopter agrees to keep CPR notified at (864) 580 0639 at all times of their current address and phone number to ensure return of Dog in the event it goes astray.

**REPORT LOSS OR THEFT:** Adopter agrees to immediately notify CPR by phone at (864) 580 0639 or (864) 489-3559 if Dog is lost or stolen, and to make a diligent effort to find Dog by posting "lost" notices in the relevant neighborhood, informing neighbors door-to-door and reporting the loss to all area pounds and shelters and by advertising for three weeks in the local paper.

**If CPR finds through credible evidence that the adopter is or ever has used any type of electronic "shock" collars for the purposes , including but not limited to, training or containment than CPR has the right to demand and seek the immediate return of the adopted animal.** \_\_\_\_\_ (Adopter's initials)

**PENALTY AND BREACH:** Adopter hereby binds herself/himself to the fulfillment of the above contract and in the event that s/he breaches this Contract or any part of its covenants, Adopter expressly agrees to cooperate in the return of Dog upon demand by CPR, and agrees to pay CPR liquidated damages in the amount of \$1000.00 plus any attorney fees and costs incurred by CPR in connection therewith \_\_\_\_\_ (Adopter's initials)

Enforcement of these damages does not prevent CPR from pursuing another remedy. Adopter further agrees that Marion County, Florida (Ocala, Florida) courts have exclusive jurisdiction over the enforcement of breach of this contract. Adopter further agrees that Florida law is controlling in any litigation and that Florida laws will apply to any remedy sought pursuant to litigation by either the Petitioner or the Respondent.

Adopter understands that this Contract is binding on her/his heirs and is not assignable. In the event that the adopter can no longer care for the animal or untimely demise of the adopter The animal must be returned to CPR. This instrument contains the entire agreement between the parties and no statement, promise or inducement made by any part or agent of any part that are contained in this agreement shall be valid or binding.

In the event CPR discovers the neglect or inhumane treatment of this Dog, it is agreed CPR has the right to immediately take possession of Dog and that written notice to the adopter at the residence of the Dog will be given after the Dog is removed from the residence.

**FOLLOW UP, RETURN OF DOG:** Adopter agrees that CPR has the right at any time to follow up on this adoption through phone, e-mail and home visits. It is understood and accepted by the adopter that home visits may be conducted by a person representing CPR, to check on the welfare of the above named Dog. In the event it is determined by either a CPR representative or the adopter that the Dog should not remain with the adopter, it is agreed the Dog shall be returned to CPR by the adopter. The Dog may not be transferred to another owner without the express written consent of CPR. If euthanasia becomes necessary, it is agreed this will be performed by a licensed veterinarian.

I CERTIFY THAT THE INFORMATION GIVEN TO CPR BY ME AS THE ADOPTER IS TRUTHFUL AND ACCURATE.

I hereby certify that an agent for CPR has explained CPR's adoption policies to me and I have read the above and agree to be bound by the terms of this Contract.
